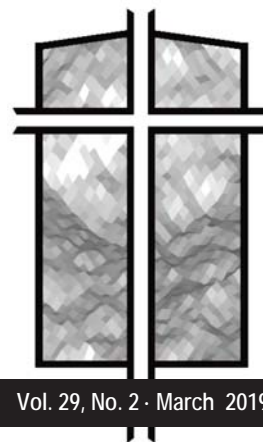

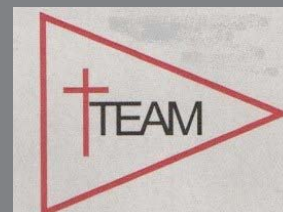
Vision and Mission

One of our most visited webpages is now being filled with Lenten resources in this diocese and from the wider church. diocesemo.org/lent

New this year, one of the last actions of the bishop's task force on baptism is creating a Lenten resource, a daily devotional titled "Ash Wednesday and Beyond: Daily Meditations for Lent and Holy Week." The week day meditations include scripture and questions for reflection. On Saturdays there is an overview of the week, tying themes together. Sundays are a day to share reflections from the week, and include a social media component using the #livingmybaptism hashtag.

Because of the structure, these will work well in a group discussion for a Lenten evening program or adult forum—or for individual reflection and study.

You can sign up for daily emails on the lent resource page linked above.

Also on that page you will find a number of Lenten study programs. Is your favorite or newly found treasure missing? Share it and we'll post it. We've just sent out a call for parish special services, retreats, studies, discussions, concerts, social justice actions. Expect to see this section populated in the next few days.

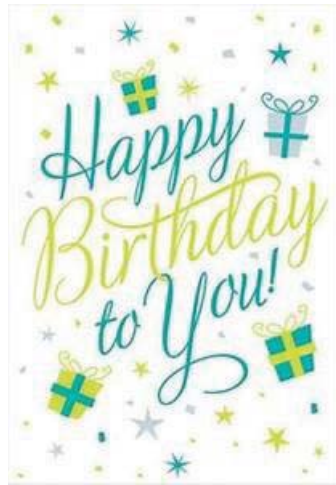
Dollar Dish

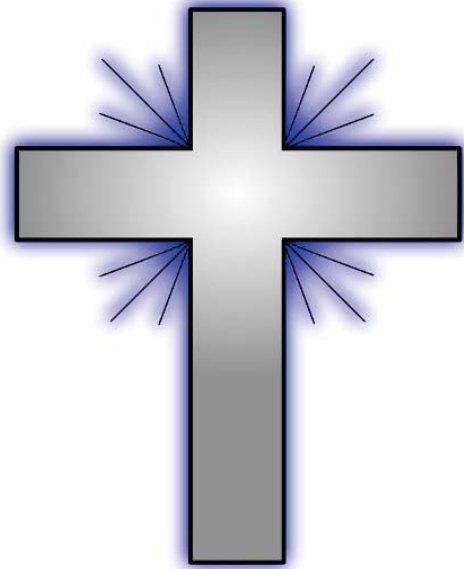

Rule #4
